Resolution EC 26-107

Title: Authorization to Apply for a Tribal Personal Responsibility Education Program Grant

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 38,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Tlingit & Haida Constitution, the Executive Council is the governing body of Tlingit & Haida when the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Administration for Children & Families (ACF) has announced funding under its Tribal Personal Responsibility Education Program (TPRE); and

WHEREAS, TPRE funds American Indian and Alaska Native (AI/AN) tribes and tribal organizations to implement culturally appropriate youth pregnancy prevention education programs; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida intends to apply for up to \$300,000 in funds from the ACF for a five-year project, and such funding includes the full amount of Tlingit & Haida's federally approved indirect rate; and

WHEREAS, such funding would support program staffing, curriculum implementation, community partnerships, cultural programming, youth engagement activities, evaluation, travel, supplies and other allowable expenses necessary to successfully administer the Tribe PREP program and improve outcomes for Tribal youth and families; and

WHEREAS, such funding would further provide culturally responsive, evidence-based pregnancy prevention and adulthood preparation education to middle and high school youth in Juneau and Angoon; and



WHEREAS, youth will benefit from age-appropriate instruction in healthy relationships, healthy life skills, and education and career success, along with weekly group sessions, individualized support, family engagement, cultural activities, and connections to trusted adults;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska hereby authorizes the Tlingit & Haida President, or designee, to submit, negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents, including any subsequent amendments, that are required by the Administration for Children & Families for granting funds to Tlingit & Haida; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, if awarded under acceptable terms, Tlingit & Haida will administer the project designed to improve outcomes for Tribal youth and families.

ADOPTED this 13th day of August 2026, by the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska, by a vote of 4 yeas, 0 nays, 0 abstentions and 3 absences.
