Resolution EC 26-112

Title: Authorization to Apply for Boys & Girls Clubs of America T.R.A.I.L. Grant

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 38,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Tlingit & Haida Constitution, the Executive Council is the governing body of Tlingit & Haida when the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida is dedicated to preserving sovereignty, strengthening communities, and promoting the health, education, and well-being of Tribal citizens; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida's Youth Engagement Division provides culturally responsive programs that promote youth leadership, healthy lifestyles, positive relationships, recreation, cultural connection, and overall youth development; and

WHEREAS, The Boys & Girls Clubs of America will open the 2026 funding opportunity for the T.R.A.I.L. (Tribal Recreation, Activity, Inclusion & Leadership) grant to support Tribal youth recreation, wellness, leadership development, and culturally relevant programming; and

WHEREAS, the T.R.A.I.L. grant aligns with Tlingit & Haida's strategic priorities by expanding opportunities for Tribal youth to participate in safe, engaging, and culturally-grounded activities that strengthen physical, social, emotional, and cultural well-being;



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Central Council of the Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska authorizes the Youth Engagement Division to prepare and submit an application to the Boys & Girls Clubs of America for the 2026 T.R.A.I.L. (Tribal Recreation, Activity, Inclusion & Leadership) Grant; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that no indirect costs shall be charged to this grant, and all eligible expenditures may be reimbursed directly from the award in accordance with the approved grant budget and Boys & Girls Clubs of America grant requirements; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this exception applies only to the Boys & Girls Clubs of America T.R.A.I.L. Grant and shall not establish precedent or modify Tlingit & Haida's federally approved indirect cost policy for any other grant or funding source; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska hereby authorizes the Tlingit & Haida President, or designee, to submit, negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents, including any subsequent amendments, that are required by the Boys & Girls Clubs of America for the 2026 T.R.A.I.L. (Tribal Recreation, Activity, Inclusion & Leadership) Grant;

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Tlingit & Haida Chief Financial Officer, Chief Executive Officer, and other authorized officials are directed to take any actions necessary to process reimbursement requests under the temporary exception set forth in this Resolution.

ADOPTED this 13th day of August 2026, by the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska, by a vote of 4 yeas, 0 nays, 0 abstentions and 3 absences.
