Resolution EC 26-97

Title: Authorization to Apply for Administration for Community Living Funding

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 38,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Tlingit & Haida Constitution, the Executive Council is the governing body of Tlingit & Haida when the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Administration for Community Living (ACL) has announced funding under its Alzheimer's Disease Programs Initiative (ADPI); and

WHEREAS, the program's mission is to increase capacity to deliver dementia-capable home and community-based services (HCBS) in Indian Country; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida intends to apply for up to \$300,000 per year in funds from the ACL for a three-year project, and such funding includes the full amount of Tlingit & Haida's federally approved indirect rate; and

WHEREAS, the ACL requires a 10 percent match that can be satisfied with non-federal in-kind contributions and compact funding; and

WHEREAS, such funding would be used to enhance the Elder Connection program and hire one Elder Liaison who would plan and coordinate how to raise awareness around the topics related to aging; and

WHEREAS, such funding would further be used to develop and provide trainings, coordinate with community partners, develop and provide an assessment to identify needs, and help connect Elders to tribal and community resources;

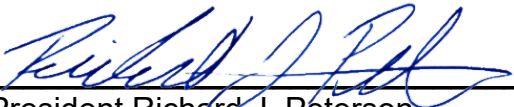


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska hereby authorizes the Tlingit & Haida President, or designee, to submit, negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents, including any subsequent amendments, that are required by Administration for Community Living; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, if awarded under acceptable terms, Tlingit & Haida will execute the Alzheimer's Disease Programs Initiative grant to implement tribal and community resource access to Elders.

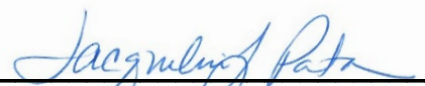
