Resolution EC 22-70

Title: Authorization to Apply for State of Alaska, Recovery Housing Program Grant

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 34,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, under Article X of the Tlingit & Haida Constitution, the Executive Council is the governing body of Tlingit & Haida when the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida has identified as a priority the development of reentry programs and services to address the needs of citizens returning to the community from incarceration; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida currently owns three properties ideal for the use of reentry and recovery housing; and

WHEREAS, such properties allow for the safety, stability, and security of individuals re-entering society and programming is grounded in culture-centered practices and traditional values; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska, Department of Health and Social Services, Division of Behavioral Health, has announced FY2023 funding is available and is seeking proposals from eligible applicants to provide services through the State Opioid Response: Recovery Housing Grant; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida intends to apply for up to \$77,770 in funds from the State of Alaska to fund the period from March 1, 2023 through June 30, 2023, and such funding includes the full amount of Tlingit & Haida's federally approved indirect rate;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska hereby authorizes the Tlingit & Haida President, or designee, to submit, negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents, including any subsequent amendments, that are required by the State of Alaska, Department of Health and Social Services, Division of Behavioral Health for granting funds to Tlingit & Haida for the proposed Recovery Housing Grant.


