Resolution EC 26-37

Title: Authorization to Apply for Institute of Museum and Library Services Native American Library Enhancement Grant

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 38,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Tlingit & Haida Constitution, the Executive Council is the governing body of Tlingit & Haida when the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS) has announced its Native American Library Services Enhancement Grants; and

WHEREAS, the goal of the program is to develop, enhance, or disseminate practices, programs, models, tools, or library staff training to strengthen library and archival services for Native American Tribes; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida intends to apply for up to \$150,000 in funds from IMLS for a two-year project, and such funding includes the full amount of Tlingit & Haida's federally approved indirect rate; and

WHEREAS, such funds will be used for providing cultural art classes, ensuring knowledge is passed down to future generations.

WHEREAS, the project will support the preservation of traditional arts, enhance cultural education, and expand access to museum and library collections;



NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska hereby authorizes the Tlingit & Haida President, or designee, to submit, negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents, including any subsequent amendments, that are required by the Institute of Museum and Library Services for granting funds to Tlingit & Haida for the proposed project.

ADOPTED this 26th day of March 2026, by the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska, by a vote of 6 yeas, 0 nays, 0 abstentions and 0 absences.
