Resolution EC 26-40

Title: Authorization to Apply for an Alaska 21st Century Community Learning Centers Grant

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 38,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Tlingit & Haida Constitution, the Executive Council is the governing body of Tlingit & Haida when the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Education & Early Development administers the Alaska 21st Century Community Learning Centers (21st CCLC) program, which provides funding to support out-of-school time programs that offer academic enrichment opportunities, youth development activities, and family engagement services for students attending schools with high concentrations of economically disadvantaged students; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Alaska 21st CCLC program is to provide safe, supportive learning environments during non-school hours where youth can receive tutoring, academic assistance, enrichment activities, and opportunities that support student success, career readiness, and positive youth development; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida intends to apply for up to \$900,000 per year for a five-year project period through the Alaska Department of Education & Early Development for the Alaska 21st Century Community Learning Centers program, and such funding includes the full amount of Tlingit & Haida's federally approved indirect rate;



WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida intends to expand youth engagement programming that will provide culturally responsive academic support, enrichment activities, and youth development programming designed to support student achievement and strengthen connections between youth, families, schools, and community resources in Southeast Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the proposed program will focus on providing a combination of academic assistance, educational enrichment, cultural learning opportunities, and family engagement activities that promote positive youth development and improved educational outcomes for participating students; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida will collaborate with schools, community organizations, and other partners to implement program activities that support student learning, build life and leadership skills, and create safe and engaging after-school environments for youth;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska hereby authorizes the Tlingit & Haida President, or designee, to submit, negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents, including any subsequent amendments, that are required by U.S. Department of Labor Employment and Training Administration for granting funds to Tlingit & Haida for the proposed Reentry and Recovery Workforce Development Program.

ADOPTED this 26th day of March 2026, by the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska, by a vote of 6 yeas, 0 nays, 0 abstentions and 0 absences.
