Resolution EC 26-45

Title: Authorization to Apply Administration for Children & Families Non-Competing Continuation Funding

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 38,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Tlingit & Haida Constitution, the Executive Council is the governing body of Tlingit & Haida when the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida received an Administration for Children & Families (ACF) five-year grant which supports ACF's vision of "resilient, safe, healthy, and economically secure children, youth, families, and communities;" and

WHEREAS, such funding under the current award is being used for early intervention and prevention services for Tribal families at risk of child abuse or neglect; and

WHEREAS, such funding is also used for expanding access to financial and support services for relative caregivers; and increasing the number of licensed tribal foster homes; and

WHEREAS, the ACF has invited Tlingit & Haida to submit a non-competitive continuation application; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida intends to apply for up to \$215,000 in funds from the ACF for a one-year project, and such funding includes the full amount of Tlingit & Haida's federally approved indirect rate; and

WHEREAS, such funds will be used to fund in-home case management services and mandatory travel required by ACF



NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska hereby authorizes the Tlingit & Haida President, or designee, to submit, negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents, including any subsequent amendments, that are required by Administration for Children & Families for granting funds to Tlingit & Haida for the proposed project.


