Resolution EC 26-47

Title: Authorization to Apply for a Bureau of Justice Assistance Grant

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 38,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Tlingit & Haida Constitution, the Executive Council is the governing body of Tlingit & Haida when the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) has announced funding under its Comprehensive Opioid, Stimulant, and Substance Use, Site-Based Program; and

WHEREAS, BJA seeks to develop, implement or expand comprehensive programs in response to overdose deaths, illicit opioids, stimulants, and other substances of abuse; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida intends to apply for up to \$1,000,000 in funds from the Bureau of Justice Assistance for a three-year project, and such funding includes the full amount of Tlingit & Haida's federally approved indirect rate; and

WHEREAS, such funds would be used for the distribution of naloxone kits and provide overdose response training to first responders and community members; and

WHEREAS, further these funds would be used to provide ongoing education and training for Village Public Safety Officers, while enhancing and strengthening referral pathways to partner agencies;




NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska hereby authorizes the Tlingit & Haida President, or designee, to submit, negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents, including any subsequent amendments, that are required by the Bureau of Justice Assistance for granting funds to Tlingit & Haida for the proposed project.

ADOPTED this 17<sup>th</sup> day of April 2026, by the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska, by a vote of 5 yeas, 0 nays, 0 abstentions and 1 absences.
