Resolution EC 24-113

Title: Authorization to Apply for a U.S. Geological Survey Collaborative Partnership

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 37,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, under Article X of the Tlingit & Haida Constitution, the Executive Council is the governing body of Tlingit & Haida when the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida would like to partner with the United States Geological Survey (USGS) in order to put up rainfall monitoring stations in various areas throughout Southeast Alaska; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida intends to apply for up to \$123,234 from the USGS end of year funds for a one year project, and such funding includes the full amount of Tlingit & Haida's federally approved indirect rate; and

WHEREAS, these funds would be used to train volunteers in associated communities on how to maintain monitoring stations;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska hereby authorizes the Tlingit & Haida President, or designee, to submit, negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents, including any subsequent amendments, that are required by U.S. Geological Survey for granting funds to Tlingit & Haida for the proposed collaboration.


