Resolution EC 24-115

Title: Authorization to Apply for the U.S. Institute of Museum & Library Services Grant

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 37,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, under Article X of the Tlingit & Haida Constitution, the Executive Council is the governing body of Tlingit & Haida when the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, cultural programs serve as a vibrant focal point for tribal citizens to learn and experience cultural arts and activities; and

WHEREAS, these programs encompass a diverse range of traditional artwork such as cedar weaving, Ravenstail weaving, button robe and octopus bag making, along with formline classes; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida operates a tribal library; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Institute of Museum & Library Services (IMLS) Native American/Native Hawaiian Museum Services offers a grant program that "is designed to support Indian Tribes and organizations that primarily serve and represent Native Hawaiians in sustaining indigenous heritage, culture, and knowledge;" and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida intends to apply for up to \$250,000 in funds from the IMLS for a one year project, and such funding includes the full amount of Tlingit & Haida's federally approved indirect rate; and

WHEREAS, these funds will support cultural programs and the purchase of climate controlled display case(s) which will protect sacred objects in Tlingit & Haida's care;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska hereby authorizes the Tlingit & Haida President, or designee, to submit, negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents, including any subsequent amendments, that are required by U.S. Institute of Museum & Library Services for granting funds to Tlingit & Haida for the proposed enhancement funds.

ADOPTED this 25th day of October 2024, by the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska, by a vote of 6 yeas, 0 nays, 0 abstentions and 0 absences.
