## Resolution EC 24-122

Title: Authorization for South Franklin Street Property Renovations

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 37,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, under Article X of the Tlingit & Haida Constitution, the Executive Council is the governing body of Tlingit & Haida when the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida authorized the acquisition and development of property on South Franklin Street in Juneau, Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the property is intended to augment the Tribe's presence in Juneau, Alaska while furthering the Tribe's objective of economic sovereignty; and

WHEREAS, the development of the property will entail renovations to transform the interior of the three-story building; and

WHEREAS, renovations to each floor will create space suited for a café, for making, displaying and selling Tlingit and Haida art, and adequate space for the existing Printing and Engraving department; and

WHEREAS, the renovations would cost \$2,255,000, which cost requires external financing, through Northrim Bank;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska hereby authorizes the Tlingit & Haida President, or designee, to submit, negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents, including any subsequent amendments, for the renovations to the South Franklin Street property.

ADOPTED this 18<sup>th</sup> day of November 2024, by the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska, by a vote of 4 yeas, 0 nays, 0 abstentions and 2 absences.
