Resolution EC 24-129

Title: Authorization to Apply for Alaska Head Start Stabilization Grant for Fiscal Year 2025

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 37,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, under Article X of the Tlingit & Haida Constitution, the Executive Council is the governing body of Tlingit & Haida when the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida has over forty years of experience administering the Head Start program, providing children and families with quality and comprehensive early childhood services that promote school readiness; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Head Start Association (AHSA) has announced Head Start funding for fiscal year 2025; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida intends to apply for up to \$200,000.00 from the Alaska Head Start Stabilization Grant for FY 2025, and such funding includes the full amount of Tlingit & Haida's federally approved indirect rate; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida will use these funds for operational costs to run fifteen (15) classroom throughout Southeast Alaska: Juneau (5), Petersburg (1), Saxman (1), Klawock (1), Wrangell (1), Yakutat (1), Sitka (2), Angoon (1), Craig (1), and Hoonah (1);

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska hereby authorizes the Tlingit & Haida President, or designee, to submit, negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents, including any subsequent amendments, that are required by Alaska Head Start Association for granting funds to Tlingit & Haida for the proposed 2025 fiscal year.

ADOPTED this 22nd day of November 2024, by the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska, by a vote of 6 yeas, 0 nays, 0 abstentions and 0 absences.
