Resolution EC 24-36

Title: Authorization to Apply for U.S. Senate Appropriations

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 37,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, under Article X of the Tlingit & Haida Constitution, the Executive Council is the governing body of Tlingit & Haida when the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Senate has announced that it is accepting submissions for Congressionally Directed Spending and programmatic requests; and

WHEREAS, the following appropriations would support Tlingit & Haida operations:

- \$500,00 for Native American Graves Protection and Repatriation Act position and program costs;
- \$1.5 million for equipment and infrastructure for the emergency operations center;
- \$2 million for modular buildings to house Village Public Safety Officers;
- \$2 million for transboundary monitoring of rivers;
- \$2 million for a trade industry apprenticeship program;
- \$1 million to purchase land for broadband towers;
- \$1 million for regional firefighting management and training; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida intends to apply for up to \$10 million in funding for multi-year projects, and such funding includes the full amount of Tlingit & Haida's federally approved indirect rate;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska hereby authorizes the Tlingit & Haida President, or designee, to submit, negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents, including any subsequent amendments, that are required for the proposed projects.


