Resolution EC 24-82

Title: Authorizing Representatives to Affiliated Tribes of Northwest Indians

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 37,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, under Article X of the Tlingit & Haida Constitution, the Executive Council is the governing body of Tlingit & Haida when the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida is a member in good standing with the Affiliated Tribes of Northwest Indians; and

WHEREAS, based on Tlingit & Haida's tribal enrollment, Tlingit & Haida shall have 350 votes;

- 8. Randy Estrin, Emerging Leader
