Resolution EC 25-121

Title: Authorization to Apply for an Administration for Children and Families Grant

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 38,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, under Article IV of the Tlingit & Haida Constitution, the Executive Council is the governing body of Tlingit & Haida when the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Administration for Children & Families (ACF) has announced funding for a grant designed to “learn how tribal governments or consortia can best provide services to tribal families at risk of child abuse or neglect”; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida provides financial assistance to families with dependent children while emphasizing work participation, education, family stability and responsibility through Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF); and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida intends to apply for up to \$1,060,000 in funds from the ACF for a five-year project, and such funding includes the full amount of Tlingit & Haida’s federally approved indirect rate; and

WHEREAS, such funding will be used for one full-time equivalent Family Caseworker and any required travel to enhance the delivery of in-home case management to tribal citizens whose children are at risk of state child welfare involvement or out-of-home placement;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska hereby authorizes the Tlingit & Haida President, or designee, to submit, negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents, including any subsequent amendments, that are required by Administration for Children & Families for granting funds to Tlingit & Haida for the proposed five-year plan.

ADOPTED this 29th day of July 2025, by the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska, by a vote of 5 yeas, 0 nays, 0 abstentions and 1 absences.
