Resolution EC 25-145

Title: Authorization to Apply for a Bureau of Justice Assistance Community Based Violence Intervention and Prevention Initiative Grant

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 38,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Tlingit & Haida Constitution, the Executive Council is the governing body of Tlingit & Haida when the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) has released funding under the Community Based Violence Intervention and Prevention Initiative; and

WHEREAS, BJA states, the "funding opportunity supports law enforcement efforts to reduce violent crime and improve police-community relations through a range of cross-sector enforcement, prevention, and intervention strategies that leverage active collaboration with communities through sustained partnerships and engagement"; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida intends to apply for up to \$2,000,000 in funds from BJA for a four year project, and such funding includes the full amount of Tlingit & Haida's federally approved indirect rate; and

WHEREAS, such funds would be used to develop and deploy a program integrating behavioral health knowledge and trauma-informed practices with existing security infrastructures; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida will use a train-the-trainer model, and security guards will train other security guards in the region on these topics, with the intention of improving interactions between security and law enforcement with tribal citizens, who may struggle with mental health or substance use;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska hereby authorizes the Tlingit & Haida President, or designee, to submit, negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents, including any subsequent amendments, that are required by Bureau of Justice Assistance for granting funds to Tlingit & Haida for the proposed project.

ADOPTED this 24th day of October 2025, by the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska, by a vote of 6 yeas, 0 nays, 0 abstentions and 0 absences.
