Resolution EC 25-38

Title: Authorization to Apply for the United Way of King County Indigenous Communities Fund  
Grant Opportunity

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 38,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, under Article X of the Tlingit & Haida Constitution, the Executive Council is the governing body of Tlingit & Haida when the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, in the Lynnwood Tlingit & Haida office, cultural programs serve as a vibrant focal point for tribal citizens to learn and experience cultural arts and activities; and

WHEREAS, the Lynnwood office programs include a diverse range of traditional trades such as cedar weaving, Ravenstail weaving, button robe and octopus bag making, and formline classes; and

WHEREAS, the United Way King County Indigenous Communities Fund has announced non-competitive funding to support community's needs that are at the forefront of driving impactful change, fostering resilience and healing projects with one-year Indigenous Communities grants; and;

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida intends to apply for up to \$50,000 in funds from the United Way of King County for a one year project and such funding includes the full amount of Tlingit & Haida's federally approved indirect rate;

WHEREAS, the funding would be used to hold cultural classes in Lynnwood, Washington;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska hereby authorizes the Tlingit & Haida President, or designee, to submit, negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents, including any subsequent amendments, that are required by United Way of King County for granting funds to Tlingit & Haida for the proposed Indigenous Communities Fund.

ADOPTED this 21<sup>st</sup> day of March 2025, by the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska, by a vote of 6 yeas, 0 nays, 0 abstentions and 0 absences.
