## Resolution EC 25-64

Title: Support for Congressional Legislation to Permanently Authorize the Federal Match to Urban Indian Organizations

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 38,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, under Article X of the Tlingit & Haida Constitution, the Executive Council is the governing body of Tlingit & Haida when the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida's citizens reside in villages and urban communities throughout the United States and rely on the Indian Health Service (IHS) and Urban Indian Organizations (UIO) for medical services; and

WHEREAS, the current Medicaid statute provides that a 100% federal match rate for state expenditures applies to all services provided to American Indians and Alaskan Natives (AI/AN) for Medicaid services received through an IHS facility, whether operated by IHS or an Indian tribe or tribal organization; and

WHEREAS, the American Rescue Plan Act temporarily extended the 100% federal medical assistance percentage to UIOs for eight quarters; and

WHEREAS, a large proportion of UIO patients utilize Medicaid as payment and UIOs that provide Medicaid services are reimbursed by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) by a combination of federal and state dollars whose rates are determined by statute and vary by state; and

WHEREAS, a permanent authorization of the 100% federal match rate for UIOs would help address the chronic underfunding of the 41 Urban Indian Health Programs located in 22 states; and

WHEREAS, extending a 100% federal match would benefit states by generating savings to state general funds; and

WHEREAS, permanent authorization of the 100% federal match rate for UIOs would support AI/AN access to culturally-attuned healthcare and improve healthcare outcomes; and

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WHEREAS, the federal trust and treaty responsibilities for the provision of healthcare for AI/ANs must be upheld for AI/ANs residing in urban areas; and

WHEREAS, in October 2024, CMS approved Section 1115 Demonstration Waivers for four states, Arizona, California, New Mexico, and Oregon, to authorize the reimbursement through Medicaid of Traditional healing services; and

WHEREAS, CMS authorized Medicaid reimbursement for Traditional healing services provided at IHS clinics, Tribal clinics, and UIOs; and

WHEREAS, without a 100% match rate, states will be required to cover a percentage of the cost related to providing Traditional healing services to AI/AN Medicaid recipients receiving services at UIOs; and

WHEREAS, states have the discretion not to include UIOs when submitting their own 1115 Demonstration Waivers; and

WHEREAS, a 100% match rate for UIOs would render UIO inclusion in state frameworks budget-neutral, increasing the likelihood that states would include UIOs;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska hereby supports the permanent extension of the federal match to Urban Indian Organizations (UIOs); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tlingit & Haida President shall send letters in support of permanent extension of the federal match to UIOs to the Alaska, Washington, and California delegations in Washington, D.C.

ADOPTED this 16<sup>th</sup> day of May 2025, by the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska, by a vote of 6 yeas, 0 nays, 0 abstentions and 0 absences.
