Resolution EC 25-71

Title: Emergency Short-Term Housing

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 38,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, under Article X of the Tlingit & Haida Constitution, the Executive Council is the governing body of Tlingit & Haida when the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, we meet tribal citizens where they are at; and

WHEREAS, there is limited housing in many communities and even less temporary housing available for individuals or families experiencing the need for emergency housing when their living situation is no longer safe; and

WHEREAS, there are models available for short-term housing that have proven effective in communities; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida can support initiatives housing authorities to make short term housing available in our communities that would allow tribal citizens that are experiencing a need for immediate housing to stay in their community;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska hereby supports initiatives by tribes, housing authorities, and Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act corporations to make emergency short-term housing available in communities where tribal citizens reside.

ADOPTED this 16th day of May 2025, by the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska, by a vote of 6 yeas, 0 nays, 0 abstentions and 0 absences.
