Resolution EC 25-80

Title: Authorization to Apply for National Forest Foundation Grant

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 38,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, under Article X of the Tlingit & Haida Constitution, the Executive Council is the governing body of Tlingit & Haida when the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the National Forest Foundation has announced the availability of a conservation grant; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida is eligible to apply for the grant; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida intends to apply for up to \$72,872.00 in funds from the National Forest Foundation for a one year project, and such funding includes the full amount of Tlingit & Haida's federally approved indirect rate; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida would use these funds to support the on the ground stewardship projects of the Alaska Youth Stewards program in Angoon, Kake, Hoonah and on Prince of Wales Island; and

WHEREAS, the growth of long-term workforce development opportunities for rural and indigenous youth in Southeast Alaska, specifically, the funds will go toward crew salary, training, and supplies;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska hereby authorizes the Tlingit & Haida President, or designee, to submit, negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents, including any subsequent amendments, that are required by the National Forest Foundation for granting funds to Tlingit & Haida for the proposed project.


