Resolution EC 26-23

Title: Authorization to Apply for an Alaska Tribal Conservation District Network Grant

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 38,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Tlingit & Haida Constitution, the Executive Council is the governing body of Tlingit & Haida when the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Assembly is not in session; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Tribal Conservation District Network (ATCDN) is soliciting requests for grant proposals; and

WHEREAS, Tlingit & Haida intends to apply for up to \$40,000 in funds from the ATCDN for a 13-month project, and such funding includes the full amount of Tlingit & Haida's federally approved indirect rate; and

WHEREAS, such funds will be used to help fund the initial re-establish of the Southeast Alaska Tribal Conservation District; and

WHEREAS, the re-establishment of the Southeast Alaska Tribal Conservation District will benefit Tlingit & Haida by providing a local voice in efforts to address natural resource concerns, strengthening the government-to-government relationship with the U.S. Department of Agriculture, providing access to funding to federal conservation programs, and provide technical support to local communities to address natural resource needs;



NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Executive Council of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska hereby authorizes the Tlingit & Haida President, or designee, to submit, negotiate, execute, and administer any and all documents, including any subsequent amendments, that are required by Alaska Tribal Conservation District Network for granting funds to Tlingit & Haida for the proposed project.


