Title: ANB/ANS History Be Taught in Public and Private Schools

WHEREAS, the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska (Tlingit & Haida) is a federally recognized tribe with more than 35,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Alaska Native Brotherhood (ANB) and Alaska Native Sisterhood (ANS) has a rich history that has had a far-reaching effect on all Alaska Natives now and in the future to come, and it has had a tremendous influence on all Alaska Natives in Alaska; and

WHEREAS, ANB/ANS fought for the right to vote for Alaska Native people;

WHEREAS, ANB/ANS fought for our ancestral land and supported the work that lead to the successful claim over our land which resulted in a monetary settlement;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Eighty-Eighth Tribal Assembly of the Central Council of Tlingit & Haida Indian Tribes of Alaska delegation convened April 19-21, 2023, hereby supports the teaching of Alaska Native Brotherhood and Alaska Native Sisterhood history in public and private schools throughout Alaska.
